Advent season: Advent means 'coming'. Using the Advent Wreath to count the weeks before Christmas almost certainly originated in ancient harvest festivals of Europe.

Evergreen branches were draped as decoration, wound around wagon wheels brought inside for the winter. These year-end celebrations were also marked by feasting & lighting of lamps against the growing darkness. Early Christians adapted these traditions to fit their celebration of the birth of Christ. Although Advent wreaths originated and remain primarily a tradition for the home, many parishes incorporate them into the Liturgical environment. The Advent wreath stands in our midst as a **symbol of Christ** who comes to save.

Friday is the Feast of The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary: and Catholics are obligated to attend Mass on that day. See the tables below for Mass times in our Parishes.
